The modern private law and doctrine inherit the ancient Roman law line, reshaped by the particular legal family. Our training scheme targets ancient traditions as a common root for better understanding the nowadays trends.

The activity foresees lectures, experts – students' meetings and elaboration of articles in field of Roman law and / or its influence over latter law circles. The work will be supervised and evaluated by International Expert Council.

The idea about the school was proposed by the professors Alessandro Corbino, Carla Masi Doria, Cosimo Cascione, Konstantin Tanev, Leonid Kofanov, Lihong Zhang, Michal Skreipek, Osvaldo Sacchi, the VIII seminar *Diritto romano ed attualità*, held in Sofia and Haskovo, Oct. 6-12, 2012.

The project promoters and supporters CEI; UNWE: Interuniversity Centre for Studies of Roman Law and Romanistic Science, Regional Distance Learning Centre, Haskovo; Dipartimento di Giurisprudenza, Università di Napoli, Federico II; Centro romanistico internazionale Copanello, Centro di Studi di Diritto Romano, RAS, Mosca; Facoltà di Giurisprudenza, Università di Carlo, Praga.

The study programme depends on the students' themes. Each student confirms respective subject in the registration form (deadline until mid-March). We expect the participation confirmation ASAP, even if the subject is not yet clarified.

The school requires participation fee of 100 €, due upon the registration in Bulgaria.

The project bears the rest of the expenditures of the lecturers and the students.

The training takes place in Bulgaria, the town of Haskovo during Apr. 28 till May 4, 2014: 1. Trip Sofia – Haskovo and accommodation (28.04); 2. Lectures (Apr. 29 – May 01); 3. Private consultations (May 02, 03); 4. Departure May 04.

The lecturers propose freely their lecture up to 40 min with a subject referring the

school general subject (history of Roman law, *ius commune*, reception or Roman influence over the current legal families, including EU), bearing on mind the themes of the students' proposals.

We accept articles' final versions by June 1.

The Expert Council evaluations must be submitted by July 30. The Council proposes the best five articles for publication in international science reviews.
