The online exchange is a joint initiative of LUISS University, NHH Norwegian School of Economics, Tilburg University, Université Toulouse 1 Capitole, University of Mannheim, University of National and World Economy, and WU Vienna University of Economics and Business.

Students from the mentioned partner universities have the possibility to apply for online courses offered at other partner institutions subject to the details and conditions listed below. Please note that the conditions for application and admission differ from one institution to another depending on the local regulations.

Academic course offer

Incoming exchange students are allowed to take 1 or 2 courses offered by the bachelor programs *Global Management of Social Issues* and *Organization Studies*.

Master-level courses are open to Master students only. Students need to meet the prerequisites of the courses at the start of the semester.
