









Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTh), Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation (FinU) and University of National and World Economy (UNWE), in the frame of their bilateral agreements and with the support of SDSN Black Sea organize the 1st AUTh-FinU-UNWE Summer School on the topic "SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN THE BLACK SEA".

Given the specific circumstances of this period, the 1<sup>st</sup> Summer School will be realized in a "blended" format:

- (i) One-day webinars on Monday 27 July 2020 consisting of three 90' courses (1 ECTS) provided by: Alexander Ilyinsky, FinU, "Financial instruments for achieving sustainable development" Ivan Bozhikin, UNWE, "Social Entrepreneurship as a Critical Tool for Sustainable Development" Nikolaos Theodosiou SDSN Black Sea & Grigoris Zarotiadis, AUTh, "SDGs in the Black Sea"
- (ii) 5-days Summer School 17-22 August 2021, hosted in the Summer Camp of AUTh in Chalkidiki, on the seaside area of Poseidi next to the beach (2 ECTS).

The Camp is a fully organized establishment – reception and information stand, restaurant, minimarket, library, cinema, beach bar, open-air areas and rooms for hosting the sessions and the seminars, Wi-Fi, as well as all the necessary health and safety facilities (infirmary, lifeguards and security services in the camp). Participating students will be accommodated pairwise (2 persons in each tent) in 4-persons size camping tents. Tents will be provided and set up by the local organizers. The restaurant of the camp will provide three meals per day for the participants - breakfast, lunch and dinner.

The daily program of the Summer School will include three hours lecturing before noon (10:00 - 13:00), three hours workshop sessions in three evenings (17:00 - 20:00) and several social / entertaining activities.

Fees of **170** € will be charged for each participating student and have to be paid upon arrival in the second part of the event, on 17 August 2021.

Fees cover participation in the one-day webinar (27/7/2020), transportation from Thessaloniki to the Camp (17/8/2021) and back (22/8/2021) as well as accommodation and full catering during the period 17-22/8/2021.
