



## **Privacy notice for the Students at the University of National and World Economy**

The University of National and World Economy (hereinafter referred to as “the Controller”, “the University” or “we”) performs its activities in accordance with the Higher Education Act and the secondary legislation, the Personal Data Protection Act and the EU Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data. This document aims to inform you about all aspects of the collection and processing of your personal data by the University and the rights you have in relation to that processing.

### **What personal data does the University collect for you as our students, for what purposes and on what legal grounds?**

The University collects and processes the following categories of personal data in order to carry out the activity of the University for education and tuition of the students enrolled for full-time or part-time training in order to acquire a Bachelor's or Master's degree:

**1.1.** Your name, personal identification number, e-mail address, address, telephone, citizenship, etc. - This information is provided by you when you apply for a candidate student campaign and after you are accepted, your personal data are collected for the purpose of enrolling as a student in your chosen major. These data are processed throughout the student's study period and are used to conduct and administer the learning process, prepare protocols, keep up-to-date information on exams, credits, assessments, etc., applications for exchange programs, and issuing certificates, official notes, academic references and other documents upon the request of the student. These data are collected also for application for PhD programmes and are processed after you are enrolled as a PhD candidate.

**1.2.** Family status, health status, etc. - In some cases, the University collects and processes additional personal data for students for the purpose of participating and ranking for scholarships, application for social aid, ranking and accommodation in dormitories, issuing documents for submission to competent state authorities.



The University does not process any more data about you than is necessary for the full performance of its activity in training and educating students to obtain the relevant educational qualification degree.

### **How does the University store your personal data?**

The University keeps the personal data of the students for the entire period of the student's study until the completion of the educational qualification degree, after which the student files are archived and are stored for an unlimited period of time for the purpose of preserving the legitimate interests of the University.

The University stores your personal data in a secure, controlled access environment by taking adequate measures to prevent unauthorized access to or loss of your information, breakthroughs in our information systems, data destruction, etc. In the event that there is a risk of breach of the protection of your personal data, we will take appropriate actions and inform you promptly.

### **What rights do you have with respect to your personal data that the University processes?**

You may ask the University to give you access to the personal data processed for you, to request rectification or completion of your information, to receive the data processed for you in a machine-readable format, to object to the processing of your data, limit their processing, and withdraw your consent to processing, or request that all data be erased if the conditions and legal prerequisites are met.

You can exercise your rights by requesting by e-mail or on-site at the Students' Department of the relevant faculty where you are enrolled.

### **Who can we provide your personal information to?**

The University processes your personal data as a controller and, if necessary and solely for the purpose of carrying out its activities, may transfer your personal data to third parties - data processors.

It is possible, at the request of a state or judicial authority, and subject to a legal obligation, the University may disclose your personal data, including for national security purposes.
