UNWE Master's Degree Programmes giving access to the ENGAGE.EU GSM Programme

For 2025/26 there are **two specific master's degree programmes** offered by UNWE, which GSM is closely linked to:

- BUSINESS AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY taught in English and
- CLIMATE AND INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS taught in English

Only students who are enrolled in one of the specific master's degree programmes could be additionally admitted to GSM. Students can study GSM while enrolled at the specific master's degree programme.


