



- ❖ The Abstract of the paper must be submitted by the **20<sup>th</sup> of April 2023**.
- ❖ The Final Paper must be submitted by the **20<sup>th</sup> of May 2023**.

- ❖ Participant students can be nominated for the **Tsekouras Prize** (<http://asecu-youth.com/tsekouras-prize/>) which is awarded annually to the best presented paper at the ASECU Youth Summer School and Conference.
- ❖ Also, all participants will receive a Certificate of Attendance and Presentation (an ECTS Credit Certificate).



## ❖ Agenda

During the Summer School – Conference the following main activities will take place:

- > The conference, where students will present their papers.
- > The Summer School, where professors will present their lectures.
- > Round Table discussions, where students will work in groups and will deliver a final document on a specific topic, which will be assigned in the first day of the Summer School.
- > Various activities: interactive games, sport activities, and excursions in Chios.
- > Global Village, where delegations introduce their country through folk music, dance, traditional costumes, food, and drinks.

## ❖ Accommodation

Rooms are single or double. Each delegation will have one double and three single bedrooms, including professor's accommodation. The rooms will be cleaned daily, and each room has sheets and towels. For those who plan to go swimming it is necessary to bring their own beach towels. Internet is also available, but there is no shared computer equipment, so you need to bring your own laptops. In the dormitory you will be able to use washing and drier machines. In each floor there is a kitchen. There is a Super Market within a walking distance and the sea is just across the street.
