ABOUT

ENGAGE.EU Summer and Winter Schools are intensive programs taught by professors and lecturers from ENGAGE.EU universities. In line with the general ENGAGE.EU goals, these programs aim to provide a forum for interdisciplinary academic exchange and learning on current societal challenges. Summer and Winter Schools aim to equip students with hard and soft skills needed to tackle these challenges and act as responsible future leaders. In 2024, a summer school will be hosted at Toulouse Capitole University on the topic of "Artificial Intelligence and Societal Challenges".

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

This ENGAGE.EU Summer School will be organized as an integrated course, offering students multiple theoretical perspectives and practical skills related to artificial intelligence and societal challenges. The first component of the course program will consist of an online session, 10 June 2024. The core part of the course will then take place on campus from June 17-28, 2024. Attendance and active participation in both course components are pre-requisites for the successful completion of the summer school.

The ENGAGE.EU Summer School 2024 is targeted at students having completed 60 ECTS credits minimum at the time of application.
