

Principles of law

The purpose of “Principles of law” course for business studies students is to provide basic knowledge about the law as a system, consisting of parts, branches and the smallest unit – the legal norm. Special attention is paid to several legal branches – Constitutional law (National assembly, president, judicial system), Civil law and Commercial law (sole trader and commercial companies). Basic terms of the sub-branches of Civil law are defined and explained – Obligations law (offer, acceptance, transaction, contract, void and voidable contracts), Property law (ownership right, limited real rights, possession), Matrimonial law (marriage, marriage contract), Inheritance law (right to inherit, testament).

The course is carried out through combination of lectures with seminars, discussions, individual assignments, solving of cases.
