<b>Minimum/maximum credits &amp; workload</b>	Students from partner universities interested in taking courses at NHH can be enrolled in a <b>maximum of 4 courses</b> offered in autumn semester 2020.
<b>Academic calendar/ course schedule</b>	<p>Courses are scheduled to take place <b>between mid-August and mid-December</b>, including the exam period, with each course having its own individual schedule.</p> <p>The grading criteria are listed in the course description.</p> <p>Please see the course descriptions on NHH's website for more details.</p> <p>The courses schedules and exam dates will be published here: <a href="https://www.nhh.no/en/for-students/timetables/">https://www.nhh.no/en/for-students/timetables/</a> on <b>August 7, 2020</b>.</p> <p>Please note that <b>the online lectures start at NHH as early as from August 17</b>. Admitted students must be prepared to start the virtual exchange at NHH shortly after they receive the notification of admission.</p>

<b>Application process</b>	<p>Interested students can apply via NHH's <b>application web</b>: <a href="https://fsweb.no/soknadswb/login.jsf?inst=nhh">https://fsweb.no/soknadswb/login.jsf?inst=nhh</a>.</p> <p>This programme will not appear in the application web before <b>July 14</b>, so if you log-in and create an account before this date, please be patient and wait until the correct programme becomes open for submission of applications.</p> <p><b>Application requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Master's level: enrolment in a master's program at a partner university</li> </ul> <p><b>Application documents:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Confirmation of enrolment home university</li> <li>➤ Transcript of records</li> </ul> <p>In the application students are <b>not asked to indicate their course preferences</b> or the number of courses they would like to attend. Once a student is admitted they may choose to register for any of the 16 available courses, limited to a maximum of 4 courses in total.</p> <p>The selection will be based on an evaluation of the applicant's overall academic performance (transcript of records). NHH will notify its partner universities about the selected students. Partner universities must confirm their students' admission to NHH's courses.</p>
<b>Application period</b>	<p>The application period runs from <b>July 14 to August 1, 2020</b>.</p> <p>All applicants will be informed about the outcome of their application at the latest by August 10, 2020.</p>

<b>Fees and other administrative aspects</b>	<p><i>No fees will be charged.</i></p> <p><i>Costs for expenditures like reading materials, literature would have to be borne by the students (if applicable).</i></p>
